Blue Suede Shoes Corona Measurements. version: 25-09-2020

This document is based on the dancing protocol that has been set by the cooperation of dancing schools and other dancing organizations. This protocol has been approved by the Dutch government¹. In this document we try to interpret and apply their rules to Blue Suede Shoes events. This document serves also to make clear what we expect from our members and what the members can expect from the association during our events. We try to explain what is allowed, what is not, and what steps members need to take in certain situations.

Arriving at our events

- When arriving at our events, members are expected to disinfect their hands. The methods of disinfection will be facilitated by a responsible Blue Suede Shoes member at that event.
- At all our events we will maintain an attendance list in which we might ask our members to note down the following information when arriving;
 - a) The time of arrival at our event
 - b) Their name
 - c) Their signature
 - d) Their dancing partner for that event
- When leaving our events we might also ask our members to note down at what time they will be leaving our event.
- However in all our events we will maintain an attendance list and store that data up to at least three weeks.
- Members can join our events in two different ways. "First Come First Serve" and by registration.
- In the situation that the location of our event has space only for a maximum number of participants. We will have a First Come First Serve policy. Members that arrive earlier will have priority to enter our event over members that arrive later. When the location has reached the maximum number of people. We can't allow other members to join.
- Other events can only be joined by registration. This registration needs to be done before the start of the targeted event.

Dancing at our events

- At our events, our members need to keep 1,5 meters distance from everyone around them.
- The 1,5 meter distance measurement is allowed to be broken, when dancing at our events.
- At our events you are only allowed to dance with a single dance partner.
- At these events you are not allowed to switch from dance partner.

- In the situation that our members want to participate in 2 different Blue Suede Shoes dancing events on a single day. We only allow that our members have the same dance-partner for both of these events.

Feeling unwell

- If one of our members is feeling unwell and has developed symptoms, such as a fever, a cough, a sore throat or other corona like symptoms, we can't allow them into our events. We advise them to stay at home until they have recovered from their symptoms.
- Even if an unwell member has been tested negative for COVID-19, we still ask kindly
 of them to stay at home until they have recovered from their symptoms. With this
 measurement we hope to ensure that members participating in our events feel safe.
 Even though members might not carry the COVID-19 virus, they still might carry
 other viruses that might be transmitted to other members.
- In the situation that a member is tested positively for COVID-19 and was at one of our events while carrying the virus, we kindly ask this member to report this to one of the board members. With this information the board can act responsibly to prevent further spread of the virus. We will make sure that the identity of the positively tested member stays anonymous within the association.

Miscellaneous

- We might maintain different or extra measurements during our events. But in those situations we will make sure that these extra measurements will be clearly communicated to our members. This communication may be done in the following manners; at the event, through our newsletter, or through other official Blue Suede Shoes communication channels.
- This document is not set in stone and might be adjusted in the future when changes are needed.

Definitions

- Events; Our events are activities that are organised by Blue Suede Shoes and that take place in locations that are rented or reserved by Blue Suede Shoes. Examples of these events are,
 - a) ballroom practices
 - b) tango practices
 - c) technique lessons
 - d) dance parties
 - e) hangout events
